## Dog Friendly Beaches

As far as we can determine from the Cornwall Council website a daytime ban will apply to Sennen beach again in 2011.

The restrictions apply from 1st May to 30th September.

Registered charity dogs such as dogs for the blind are excluded from the restrictions.

Cornwall Council point you at the [Visit Cornwall website](#) which we assume is the definitive list of dog friendly beaches in Cornwall.

<b>Portheras Cove</b> Just beyond Pendeen on the north coast.
<b>Cape Cornwall (Priest's Cove)</b> The beach below the car park at Cape Cornwall
<b>Porthnaven</b> Accessible from Cape Cornwall on the Cot Valley road. There is a small car park at the bottom of the valley above the beach.
<b>Progo</b> Just south of Porthnaven
<b>Gwenver</b> Just to the north of Sennen beach. Just follow the coast path from behind the Beach restaurant or drop down from the car park on the Tregiffian road.
<b>Nanjizal (Mill Bay)</b> Off the coast path to the south of Land's End.
<b>Pednevounder</b> To the east of Porthcurno. Also a nudist beach apparently; your dog can go naked!
